

Insight Cuba is the sole organizer, packager and operator of the related transactions to Cuba described in this brochure. Insight Cuba is located at 2 Clinton Place, New Rochelle, NY 10801, 800-450-

Insight Cuba is licensed by the United States Treasury Department's Office of Foreign Assets Control to engage in the travel-related and other transactions incidental to the travel program described in this brochure, and to authorize United States persons to travel on those programs under Insight Cuba's auspices. The travel programs described in this brochure provide a full-time schedule of educational exchanges through people-to-people contact. United States law requires that all persons traveling to Cuba to participate in these travel programs adhere to the full-time schedule and imposes upon Insight Cuba the obligation to ensure such adherence.



#### Rates

Published prices are based on land only, and do not include international airfare to or from the U.S. On-tour transportation is included as indicated on each tour program. Land only rates are guaranteed upon receipt of deposit. Printed rates are subject to change without notice.

Programs are land-only. Due to U.S. public charter regulations, booking air to Cuba from the U.S. is unlike other destinations. After you have booked one of Insight Cuba's programs, they will secure your roundtrip flight to Cuba.

#### Holiday Rates and Programs

Holidays or special events may carry additional surcharges, payment requirements and cancellation penalties. During holidays or special events, sites such as museums, restaurants and shopping may be limited or not available.

#### Mandatory Guest information

Personal information including passport number, birth date, and other information are required at the time of booking to reserve your space. Names on your reservation must match the first and last name listed on your passport. Your passport must be valid for six months after your return to the U.S. Your confirmation includes a Participant Profile packet to make it easy for you to provide this information.

#### Deposit

A \$275 deposit, payable by credit card, is due at the time of booking. Please have credit card information, home address, telephone number and email ready. Credit card statements will reflect Cross-Cultural Solutions as the company charging your card.

#### Final Payment

Final payment is required 60 days prior to departure, along with the completed Participant Profile packet, including a signed Agreement and Release, Mandatory Guest Information, and a copy of your passport. Reservations made within final payment periods require full payment at the time of booking.

#### Changes to Reservations

Changes are considered cancelled services and cancellation penalties apply. Changes are subject to additional fees should the original rates no longer be available for your revised travel dates. If available, changes from double occupancy to single occupancy will incur a single supplement charge.

#### Cancellations

Cancellations are subject to the following per person fees:

- The \$275 deposit is non-refundable. If the cancellation is effective,
- Up to 91 days prior to departure, \$275 per person penalty plus applicable airline cancellation penalties.
- 90 to 61 days prior to departure, \$275 per person penalty plus 25% of the program cost plus applicable airline cancellation penalties.
- 60 to 45 days prior to departure, \$275 per person penalty plus 50% of the program cost plus applicable airline cancellation penalties.
- 44 to 31 days prior to departure, \$275 per person penalty plus 75% of the program cost plus applicable airline cancellation penalties.

• Within 30 days prior to departure, 100% penalty.

No refunds will be made for unused portions of the program.

#### **Changes to Programs**

Insight Cuba will make every effort to operate all programs as disclosed on our website or literature. However, circumstances beyond Insight Cuba's control may arise which would require an adjustment to the tour or its inclusions. Insight Cuba will do all that is possible to avoid such changes but reserves the right to make such modifications. Normal cancellation penalties still apply to the program that has been changed.

#### **Tour Documents**

Documents are mailed approximately 2 weeks prior to departure for all tours. Documents for all passengers cannot be released until full payment and the Participant Profile packet have been received.

#### Hotels

Insight Cuba must reserve the right to substitute hotels if absolutely necessary. Please note that it is standard policy that hotel rooms are not available for check-in before 3 p.m. Single rooms are often smaller than twin rooms. Triple rooms may not be available or may consist of a rollaway, cot, temporary bed or mattress in a twin room, and may not be comfortable for three adults.

#### Gratuities

Gratuities for the trip leader, local guides, drivers, and others are not included unless indicated and are at the discretion of the individual traveler.

**Travelers Requiring Special Assistance** 

Any disability requiring special attention should be reported at the time the reservation is made. Insight Cuba will make reasonable attempts to accommodate the special needs of such travelers, but are not responsible for any denial of services by carriers, hotels, and other independent suppliers. Insight Cuba regrets that it cannot provide individual assistance to a tour member for walking, dining, getting on and off motor coaches, and other transportation vehicles, or other personal needs. Travelers who need such assistance must be accompanied by a qualified companion.

### Many Sites in Cuba Require Careful Walking and Alertness

Sightseeing, either guided or "on your own," requires walking over uneven stones and unpaved surfaces, climbing steep stairs and paths that may have no railings, and exploring when weather conditions are wet. Travelers who choose to travel with Insight Cuba assume responsibility for their personal safety, whether guided or during free time.

#### Responsibility

Insight Cuba (the "Operator"), a division of Cross-Cultural Solutions, organizes, packages and operates these programs. General Tours is not responsible for these programs or for any matter in connection with or arising out of same. The tour services described in this brochure, including without limitation transportation, lodging, and sightseeing, are provided by the carrier, hoteliers, and other suppliers that are independent contractors and not agents for, employees, partners, or joint ventures of the Operator. The Operator is not responsible for the acts or omissions of such independent contractors whether as principal or agent. Tickets, vouchers, and other travel documents are subject to all terms and conditions of the respective suppliers (some of them may limit or exclude the supplier's liability). Neither the Operator nor General Tours is responsible for any loss of or damage to property or death or injury to persons, resulting from any act or omission of any supplier providing any tour service or any other person or entity or caused by strike, war, weather, quarantine, sickness, government restriction or regulation, or any other cause beyond its reasonable control, including supplier's decision to withdraw and/or cancel a tour for any reason. The tour participant expressly waives all rights, which he or she may have against the Operator or General Tours in connection with the foregoing. Under no circumstances is the Operator or General Tours to be construed as a carrier under contract for safe carriage of the passenger or his or her baggage and belongings. The Operator reserves the right to remove a client from a tour and provide a full refund for unused services.

In addition, neither the Operator nor General Tours is responsible for any costs or loss that a Participant may incur because of any act or failure to act by any governmental entity, including any delay or change of travel plans caused by any action by any governmental entity including changes to the Cuban Asset Control travel regulations to Cuba which may prohibit travel.

#### **Disputes**

All matters concerning these tour programs and services shall be governed by, and administered and interpreted according to the laws of the State of New Hampshire (without regard to conflicts of laws principles).

Any unresolved dispute or controversy arising under or in connection with the services provided by General Tours or Insight Cuba shall be settled exclusively by arbitration, conducted before the American Arbitration Association in, respectively, Boston, Massachusetts or New York, New York, in accordance with the rules of that body then in effect. In addition, the arbitrator and not any federal, state, or local court or agency shall have exclusive authority to resolve any dispute relating to the interpretation, applicability, enforceability, conscionability, or formation of this contract, including but not limited to a claim that all or any part of this contract is void or voidable. The arbitrator shall not have the authority to add to, detract from, or modify any provision hereof nor to award punitive damages to any injured party. A decision by the arbitrator shall be final and binding. Judgment may be entered on the arbitrator's award in any court having jurisdiction. Each party shall be responsible for the respective fees and expenses of their legal representation and the costs of arbitration shall be shared equally.

Legal proceedings against General Tours may be instituted only in a state or federal court within the State of New Hampshire, and any claim involved in such proceedings shall be decided in accordance with the laws of the State of New Hampshire. Any legal proceeding against Insight Cuba must be commenced within one year following the date of tour completion. Neither Insight Cuba, General Tours, nor any affiliate of either shall in any case be liable for other than compensatory damages, and you hereby waive any right to punitive damages.

Every effort has been made to accurately produce the information in this brochure. We reserve the right to correct errors.

#### Passports and U.S. Visas

U.S. citizens are required to have a passport valid for six months after the return from their trip. Participants holding a passport from a foreign country, green card, U.S. Visa, or special use passport are solely responsible for understanding the limitations imposed on their passport, green card, U.S. Visa, or special use passport regarding re-entry back into the United States. Neither Insight Cuba nor General Tours is responsible if a participant is refused service by an airline carrier or entry into Cuba because of a restricted U.S. Visa or Passport. In the

event the participant is refused entry to Cuba because of Visa or Passport issues, applicable cancellation penalties will apply. U.S. citizens' visas for travel to Cuba will be included with clients' final travel documents.

### Adherence to Government Regulations Regarding Travel to Cuba

It is the Participant's responsibility to be familiar with the travel restrictions involving travel to Cuba. Participants are required to follow and fulfill travel requirements, including all legal requirements, including the restrictions set forth in the U.S. Treasury regulations. Failure to comply will lead to expulsion from the program in Cuba and may subject Participant to criminal or civil penalties. #### Insurance
